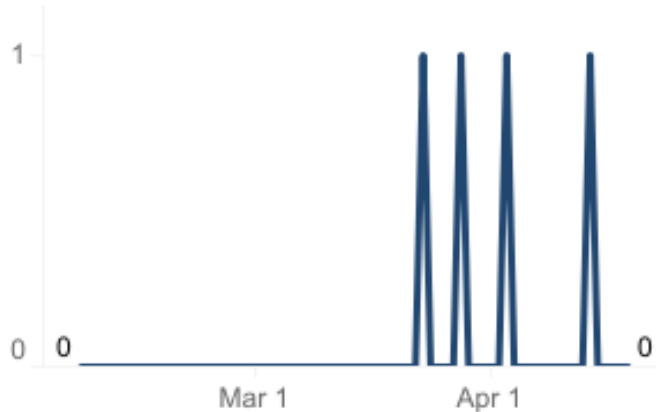

OVERVIEW:

Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a respiratory illness that can spread from person to person. The virus that causes COVID-19 is a novel coronavirus that was first identified during an investigation into an outbreak in Wuhan, China. The World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a global pandemic on March 11, 2020.

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What is *Contact Tracing?*



Person shows symptoms and tests positive for COVID-19.



Patient is provided care, isolated & asked about close contacts by the Health Department.



Close contacts are identified by the Health Department, put into quarantine, & monitored for 14 days.



Contact shows symptoms and tests positive for COVID-19.



Patient is provided care, isolated & asked about close contacts by the Health Department.



If no contacts, no further spread of the disease.



Missed contacts may spread the disease to new contacts.



Health Department works to eliminate missed contacts.



Contact shows no symptoms after 14 days.



Contact is dismissed from quarantine.

Isolation separates sick people with a contagious disease from people who are not sick.

Quarantine separates and restricts the movement of people who were exposed to a contagious disease to see if they become sick.

Stay connected & support those who are in isolation or quarantine. Call, text or video chat. Send a letter. Drop off meals at their door. Offer to run errands or do yard work. We're all in this together. **#InThisTogetherOhio**
